IMPORTANT NEWS This affects all of you

England Athletics (EA) Athlete Affiliation Fees -

As reported in the last issue EA announced in September that they planned to increase the cost of affiliating athletes from £5 to £20! There were incremental increases, but this would increase the workload of Club's membership Secretaries. There was a general outcry on this issue, which resulted in EA arranging Regional Consultation Meetings, and Highgate Harriers were well represented at the meeting for Clubs based in the South.

EA have now announced that the increase will be to a flat rate of £10 per athlete, but your Committee has made the decision that until EA make it clear exactly how they intend to use this extra money we will not pay to register any of our athletes.

In the short term this will have little or no impact on athletes as we can still register without paying, so athletes will be allocated an EA number. Athlete insurance is paid through the Club's affiliation to EA, rather than individual athletes, and the Club has affiliated so all athletes are insured.

This is a major issue, the Club will present our proposals to members at our AGM, which is provisionally set for Monday 15th April. Should we accept the increase to £10 we would almost certainly have to increase membership subscriptions which would also need to be discussed at the AGM.
